IOSCO COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION RECEIVES MAJOR GIFT

The Iosco County Community Foundation (ICCF) recently received a gift of \$25,000 which will support grants to local nonprofits and scholarships for Iosco County students.

Carl and Christine Huebner, of East Tawas, have supported ICCF since its inception – both as donors, and Carl as an ICCF trustee. \$15,000 of their gift was placed in the Iosco County Community Needs Fund – an unrestricted fund that awards grants annually to programs benefiting residents of Iosco County. The remaining amount was placed in the Carl and Christine Huebner Scholarship Fund, which awards scholarships to local students pursuing a degree in the fine arts.

“Christine and I have been associated with the Iosco County Community Foundation for the past ten years and have witnessed the benefits of endowment-giving. We believe ICCF is the organization best suited to ensure that our charitable gifts are used to their fullest and will benefit the greatest number of people over the years to come,” said Carl Huebner.

The Iosco County Community Foundation has supported youth programs, our senior centers, tourism, environmental issues and gives to local charities of all kinds. The Foundation receives funds large and small, invests them, and then awards grants to nonprofit organizations.

“Unrestricted funds help the Community Foundation support the widest range of programs

in our communities,” said Barbara Willyard, Executive Director of the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan. “Because grants are determined by a board of local leaders, we have local expertise directing where funding will go to make the biggest impact possible.”

The mission of the Iosco County Community Foundation is to protect and enhance the quality of life for all present and future residents of Iosco County through the use of charitable and permanent gifts from a wide range of donors. ICCF currently has nearly \$2 million in assets and holds 40 charitable funds benefiting Iosco County. ICCF is an affiliate of the Community Foundation for Northeast Michigan.
